






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1. NOFEN Set A40 Components

- 5. Absolutely no fans are utilized, significantly reducing internal dust accumulation and making it possible to maintain system cleanliness.

NOFEN CR-100A is designed to not use the First PCI Express Slot. but can use second PCI Express Slot.









△ P-400A Precautions

- 1. The motherboard can be damaged if the Main Output Connector(P1) is connected to the motherboard while the AC power is ON.
- 2. While connecting the DC output connectors, be sure to connect them in the correct directional orientation.
- 3. After installation, press the case's power button then check if the Power LED lights ON, for if it does not, it may be necessary to check for incorrect connections or motherboard problems.







3.5" & 2.5" Converting Bay (Included)




6. Nipple and Backplate Installation on Motherboard


1. Intel CPUs

- 1. Align the Nipples, Guide Bushings, and Backplate with the motherboard's CPU cooler installation holes as shown in the diagram.
- 2. Fasten the Nipples, Guide Bushings, and Backplate to the motherboard by screwing in each of the Nipple Fixing Bolts through the assembly to their respective Nipples.



2. AMD CPUs

- 1. Remove the original screws of the motherboard's retention guide.
- 2. Align the Nipples, retention guide, and backplate with the motherboard's retention guide installation holes as shown in the diagram.
- 3. Fasten the Nipples, retention guide, and backplate to the motherboard by screwing in each of the Nipple Fixing Bolts through the assembly to their respective Nipples.






7. Motherboard Installation into Case


CAUTION: Before installing the motherboard, refer to the cautionary notice below regarding pre-installed Stand-offs for ATX motherboards and required adjustments for Micro-ATX motherboards.

- 1. Install the motherboard into the case and connect the Main Power and CPU Power onto the motherboard.
- 2. Connect the wires/connectors of the Power Switch, I/O Port, USB, and Audio according to the motherboard's manual.
- 3. Remove the 5.25" Converting Bay from the case, then install the HDD or SSD as shown in the diagram below, and connect their power cables.


8. Installing the CPU Cooler

- 1. Remove any foreign materials from the surface of the CPU.
- 2. Apply a thin layer of the included Thermal Grease on the surface of the CPU.
- 3. Align the 4 Fixing Holes(refer to p.14) of the CPU Cooler with the 4 Nipples.
- 4. Install the CPU Fixing Bolts to fix the CPU Cooler on the motherboard.







9. Cooler Fixing Holes for INTEL & AMD

Solution 1. Power – Set "CPU Fan Speed" to "Ignored" in the Hardware Monitor menu.


